- current or previous enrollment in a Family and Consumer Sciences education course.

The seminar will introduce participants to the organization and show future Family and Consumer Sciences teachers the many benefits of being an FCCLA chapter adviser. College students will learn how --

- participation in FCCLA activities helps students develop leadership skills;
- chapter members use Family and Consumer Sciences skills to meet community needs;

- advisers benefit from one-on-one contact with students outside of the school setting;
